Sampan'Asa momba ny Fampanandrosoana (SAF/FJKM), the department of development and humanitarian assistance of FJKM forms not only a strong part of the church FJKM, it is also a well-reputed national NGO, working and collaborating in the important national fora and coordination bodies, implementing technical cooperation and humanitarian aid with support of the international community to the population of Madagascar. The internships allow individuals to bring new perspectives, innovative concepts while working as part of the fundraising team of the NGO. The internship program within SAF/FJKM is the opportunity for freshly graduated people and young professionals to gather experiences on proposal designing and submission to several type of donors and grants sizes. Interns will benefit from Malagasy and International professionals and advisors coaching throughout the program.

We are actually offering to 4 motivated individuals the opportunity to grow with us in the field of:

1.) Voluntarism (strong background youth movement / adult education / DRR)

To become a part of the technical coordination with advise to FJKM about the main objective to grow up to 50 000 volunteers till 2025 of our nationwide church volunteer program involved in Disaster Preparedness and Management; environmental actors, psycho social supporters and health-hygiene promoters

2.) Food Security / Livelihoods (strong background agriculture / value chain / agro economic development)

To become a part of technical coordination of our diverse livelihoods and agricultural programs, mainly targeting small scale farmers and rural population with programs to increase their income, reduce poverty and vulnerability and promote education for individual and community development

3.) Climate Change (strong background environmental impacts, mitigation and adaption)

To become a part of our innovative climate coordination targeting the consequences of climate change to the vulnerable population of Madagascar, especially in the coastal areas but also in the South. Working with GCF, The Adaption Fund, World Bank and other major players, developing smart concepts and bringing them to paper should be your competence.

4.) Resource management (background real estate development, architecture, commercial economic law)

SAF/FJKM has a small but steadily growing department for resource mobilization, - development and – management of our assets. You will become a part of the team, which helps us to develop this important income source further, inject us with innovative ideas and the ability of competent and productive project management.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Internship, candidates must have graduate (a Master's degree at least) in the above named fields.. The internship is opened only for Malagasy Fluency in English and high writing skills are highly required. Other skills such as computing skills are logic same as some experience and knowledge about fund application processes and procedures, accountability and the basics of working with disadvantaged people. We value diversity in our workplace, and encourage all qualified individuals, particularly women and people with disability, with above-mentioned professional and academic backgrounds to apply. Our aim is to create an opportunity for young people to gather practical work experiences in our developing country.

The positions are in Antananarivo at the headquarters of SAF/FJKM, with potential travel to the East, South East and Greater South of Madagascar. SAF/FJKM will pay a monthly allowance to all Interns and provide coverage of work related travel costs for field trips in the frame of the work. .
